

## CALL FOR TENDER

### 1. Name of the procurement organization:

ST. PHILIP NERI PRIMARY SCHOOL – registered primary school

### 2. Name of the contract order:

“Purchase of solar borehole pumps for borehole in Kikombi primary school and St. Vincent Imilini Secondary School”

### 3. Description of the contract:

The scope of this contract comprises the supply, installation, testing, and commissioning of solar-powered borehole pumping systems for two (2) existing boreholes to provide a reliable and sustainable water supply to selected schools in Kaewa Ward.

The works shall be carried out at the following locations:

- Imilini Primary and Secondary School
- Kikombi Primary School

The borehole characteristics are as follows:

- Approximately 180 meters at Imilini Primary and Secondary School, volume 12m<sup>3</sup>/hour
- Approximately 250 meters at Kikombi Primary School, volume 5m<sup>3</sup>/hour

The contractor shall undertake all necessary works, including but not limited to:

- Site assessment and verification of borehole conditions
- Hydraulic and electrical design of the solar pumping systems
- Selection and supply of suitable submersible solar pumps
- Supply and installation of solar photovoltaic (PV) modules and mounting structures
- Supply and installation of pump controllers/inverters (with MPPT functionality)
- Installation of submersible pumps at recommended setting depths
- Installation of rising mains, fittings, and associated pipework
- Electrical cabling and protection systems
- Construction of pump headworks and protective structures
- System testing, commissioning, and performance verification
- Training of school representatives on operation and basic maintenance

### 4. Place and deadline for submission of the tenders:

### 5. Evaluation of the proposals:

5.1 The evaluation of the proposals is private. The Commission will evaluate the proposals in terms of complying with procurement organization requirements for subject of the contract and exclude offers that do not meet the requirements for subject of the contract stated in the call for tenders and tender documents.

### 6. Evaluation Criteria

6.1 For the evaluation of proposals the procurement organization has chosen the **lowest price criterion**.
